POSTER TIPS:

Title

Prepare a banner for the top of the poster indicating the title, author(s) and affiliation(s). Lettering on the banner should be at least one inch high.

Layout

Avoid long textual passages and use graphs and diagrams as much as possible. Use a large font size for your text, 24-point.

Arrange materials in columns rather than in rows to ensure easy viewing. Indicate the sequence of figures or graphs with numbers or letters at least one inch high.

Use thin mounting materials --heavy board is difficult to keep in place. (Push pins will be provided.)

Graphs/Illustrations

Figures should be designed to be viewed from a distance (3-4 feet).

Use clear and visible graphics.

Each figure or table should have a heading in large typeface.

Detailed information should be provided in a legend below in smaller typeface.

Figure legends should describe concisely the content of the figure and the conclusions.

Details of the methodology should be kept brief.

Presentation

Practice a short description of your key findings.

You may have copies of abstracts or handouts available for distribution.

The presenting author should be present during the entire poster presentation.
